
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 On the Municipal programme the Department has transferred R1, 358, 752, 000.00 to allocated Municipalities and they have reported an expenditure of R685, 989, 000.00 at the end of the financial year with 60 219 households electrified which includes rollovers.

- On the Eskom programme the Department has transferred R1, 982,985, 000.00 and they have reported an expenditure of R1, 276, 168, 074.87 at the end of the financial year with 106 669 households electrified which includes rollovers.
- The Department through its implementing agencies (Municipalities and Eskom) has managed to achieve **166 888** households electrified against the APP target of **137 000**.

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CHALLENGES EXPERIENCED BY INEP

 Municipalities who couldn't appoint on time could lose their funding when they apply for rollovers with National Treasury.

- ○INEP is going to lose those funding as they are going back to National Fiscus.
- Electrification projects contracted will be affected and the Department will not meet the contracted target.
- Some Municipalities are still not reporting as required in terms of the Division of Revenue Act.



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CHALLENGES EXPERIENCED BY INEP

 Department is still experiencing challenges with municipalities that are implementing uncontracted projects.



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- The allocated funding for municipalities that have not yet finalized the appointment of service providers have been recommended for reallocation to municipalities that have appointed so that funds are spent by the end of the financial year.
- The Department is going to monitor additional funding transferred to Municipalities during re-allocation to make sure they spend by end of the financial year.
- Working sessions have been arranged for those municipalities who are implementing uncontracted projects in order to follow the right process of change



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INTERVENTIONS TO DEAL WITH CHALLANGES



 Eskom has been requested to provide all the projects not implemented and funding not spent by end of March 2021 so that the Department could apply for rollover from NT.

 The Department will request Eskom to provide a recovery plan for the projects that have been affected.



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
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
